After having family and friends try out the variety of dry mix recipes she created, Cassie decided to introduce a line of products to the public under the Ohio Cottage Food Law which allowed her to mix and package the products in her home kitchen to offer for sale. Cassie's Country Cupboard became a licensed food manufacturer in March 2020 after the completion of a facility on the Menchhofer property. Products ranging from soup mixes, pancake mixes, spice blends and more can now be shipped to stores and direct to consumers throughout the United States. You can also find Cassie's Country Cupboard products in several local stores in Mercer, Auglaize, and Shelby County plus she is a long-time vendor at the Celina Farmers' Market every May-September. 





# **Adult Leadership in Action**


This past September we were excited to welcome a new group to our Leadership in Action class. This great group of business leaders have enjoyed some great experiences learning more about our local

# Chicken Tortilla Soup

- 1 Large Onion Chopped
- 2 Tablespoons Olive Oil
- 1 Can (4oz) Chopped Green Chilies
- 2 Garlic Cloves Minced
- 1 Jalapeno Pepper Seeded & Chopped
- 1 Teaspoon Ground Cumin
- 5 Cups Chicken Broth
- 1 Can (15oz) Tomato Sauce
- 1 Can (14 ½ oz) Diced Tomato with garlic 7 onion Undrained
- 3 Cans (5oz each) White Chicken Drained
- ¼ Cup Minced Fresh Cilantro
- 2 Teaspoon Lime Juice

Salt & Pepper to taste - Crushed Tortilla chips - Shredded Monterey Jack or Cheddar Cheese

In large sauce pan saute onions in oil. Add chilies, garlic, jalapeno & cumin. Stir in broth and tomato sauce & tomatoes. Bring to boil. Reduce heat stir in chicken. Simmer uncovered for 10 minutes. Add cilantro, lime juice, salt & pepper. Top with chips and cheese

Option: If you want soup to be a little creamier add a big can of Cream Of Chicken Soup.
