AWARD CRITERIA

Citizen of the Year

The recipient should be actively involved in community organizations and is a catalyst to make things happen. They are well rounded in their commitments to family, church, community, and job. A person who puts time and effort into making the lives of others better and is well respected. He/She is a very caring person who puts others first. This person is a team player capable of leading and recruiting the assistance of others.

A person with the philosophy of "service is the price you pay for the space you occupy in this world."

Humanitarian Award / Achievement Award

The recipient should be a benefactor of mankind, kind-hearted, compassionate, considerate, and unselfish. This recipient should be generous with their time and talent to better the lives of others. They have a good Samaritan philosophy with a passion for a cause which is much bigger than themselves.

One who uses their own financial resources or has the resourcefulness to know where to find assistance. One who has organized and implemented the process. The recipient has special skills and talents and often spends countless hours of time training and/or nurturing others. One who works diligently for a cause with no thought of personal gain.

This recipient should be a person/group who has been a part of making the community grow and improve in some physical or discernible way. The recipient should be a person/group of vision. The recipient should be a person/group who has, or is, contributing and accomplishing their dream for a better community.

This recipient should be a person/group who has provided, or is providing a "stepping stone" to the future. Building something of lasting value. A person/group who is building, or who spends time instilling responsibility and positive character traits in others.

Community Business Award

The selected recipient will not only be awarded at the annual chamber banquet but will also receive a \$500 scholarship to be used towards their college education or towards their growth in the workforce.
